AdriHealthMob project

Development of a Cross Border model of sustainable and efficient transport service to empower the Health and Care accessibility.

The AdriHealthMob project is realized within the Priority 3—Accessibility and Networks, Theme 2 of the IPA Adriatic Cross-Border Cooperation Programme and responds to the need to strengthen and integrate the infrastructure networks, promoting the accessibility of services.

A new model for the Adriatic Macro-Region

The project, on the strength of the participation of 15 partner from 8 different countries of the Adriatic Macro Region, pursues several ambitious objectives:

- To build up a system able to collect, organize and analyze information, data, documents, politics, economic performances and to provide statistical data that allow to plan a model able to promote accessibility of health services at the level of the Macro-Adriatic Region;
- To test the new model through pilots;
- To provide the political system of the Macro-Adriatic Region proposals, guidelines and recommendations able to develop a strategy for the cross-sectorial, integrated and sustainable transport.

The Kick off meeting

The 10th and 11th of March, Sarajevo hosted the kick-off meeting of the project with a large participation of all the partnership.

The meeting was opened by the greetings of the Bosnian Federal Minister of Health, dr. Rusmir Mesihovic which encouraged and welcomed the implementation of the project as an important opportunity for the development of mobility and accessibility to the services within the entire macro-region.

The working group, led by the Bosnian coordinator dr. Goran Cerkez of the Federal Ministry of Health and COOSS Marche, discussed about all the specific objectives, work methodology to be followed, the deadlines and the financial and administrative aspects of project management; moments of sharing and comparison were frequents and fruitful.

The meeting precisely outlined all the roles of each partner and approved the Steering Committee (SC), Joint Technical Unit (JTU), Quality Administration Assembly (QAU) and Project Management Units (PMUs) in order to optimize the work and ensure coordination, monitoring, integration and quality.

During the meeting the logo of the project has been approved, paving the way even for first action of communication and dissemination of AdriHealthMob.

ADRIATIC IPA Cross Border Cooperation Programme

The Cross Border Cooperation (CBC) is an instrument used by the European Union to strengthen cooperation between neighbouring geographic areas.

The IPA Adriatic CBC profits gramme into the context of the broader process of pre-accession IPA (Instrument for Pre-Accession) and was founded on the basis of the previous INTERREG III, with the aim of strengthening cooperation and sustainable development of

Next Actions

SUSTAINABILITY & SINERGIES

In order to record all the experiences in the field of the sustainable mobility in the social welfare sector that can be used as an instrument of accumulation and sustainability of the project, the consortium is analysing the state of the art in different countries.

Survey instruments ad procedures are shared and common such as questionnaires, face to face interviews and tools for the collection and analysis in order to gain consistent and comparable results to determine the best experiences - past, present and starting - also exploitable for the identification of possible synergies and areas of interest.

ANALYSIS & MAPPING: NEEDS-TERRITORY-SERVICES

The partnership has launched a research in different countries, with the aim of obtaining a deep mapping of territories as regards social services, health and welfare, transport services and the flows of people for social welfare reasons.

All data, collected through questionnaires distributed in each country involved in the project, will be systematized in a macro-regional database .

MEETINGS & EVENTS

During the 2014, the Partnership will have the opportunity to exchange experiences and point of view in national and transnational meetings.

The SC and JTU event are expected in Ancona, Italy from the 16th to the 18th of July and another one, will be realized in September in Cyprus, Greece.

Besides these kinds of official events and meetings of the internal entity of the project, the partners will be able to organize public events for the promotion and dissemination of AdriHealthMob Activities such as the International Workshop on the Mobility Level of Patients at Cross Border between EU and Non-EU Countries, expected in Croatia, for November.
